COAT	Frock coat: Scarlet, square-cornered skirt, no pockets or flaps on the outside except a whistle pocket, 5 brass buttons (if hunting the hounds) w/ Hunt insignia. Hunt's colors on collar. For Staff and Masters not hunting hounds, coat will have 4 buttons. If a Master chooses to wear a black coat the buttons are brass	Frock coat: Black, rounded skirt, 3 plain black buttons -or- Melton or black hunt coat, 3 plain black buttons. If Entitled: Scarlet frock coat, rounded skirt, 3 brass buttons w/ Hunt insignia, and Hunt's colors on collar- or- black or dark navy hunt coat with black buttons with Hunt insignia (no colors on collar). Single vent Ratcatcher: Tweed coat or hacking jacket in earth tones, 3 buttons, single or double vent. In warm weather at the discretion of the Masters coats may be waived	Frock coat: Black rounded skirt, 3 plain black buttons -or- Melton or black hunt coat, 3 plain black buttons, or shadbelly. If Entitled: Black or Navy frock, Melton or black hunt coat, 3 black buttons with Hunt insignia, Hunt's colors on collar. Single vent Ratcatcher: Tweed coat or hacking jacket, in earth tones, 3 buttons single or double vent. In warm weather at the discretion of the Masters coats may be waived.	A Junior is described as anyone under the age of 16. Juniors wear tweed jackets, paddock boots and Jodphurs during both cub hunting and formal season. For those age 16 and older the adult rules of proper turnout apply.

HAT	Black or dark blue velvet hunt cap, ribbons down for Masters & Staff only	Black or dark blue velvet hunt cap, ribbons up - or - with Frock coat (scarlet or black) it is permissible to wear silk hat & hat cord (if wearing a scarlet coat cord should be red), with a Melton coat it is permissible to wear a derby hat & hat cord. Ratcatcher: Brown velvet hunt cap is appropriate	Black or dark blue velvet hunt cap with ribbons up or derby with a cord, with a Melton or frock coat, ladies wear either a black velvet hunting cap or a black derby with hat cord.
